UPDATE / CHANGE for 9th Annual Youth Fishing Derby: has made a last-minute change in location. It will be held at our club's pond and we will be stocking catfish for that event. ALL other fish besides Catfish are Catch-and-Release only. The normal location of the Fishing Derby does not have enough water in either pond to fish there.
