Dave Crates spoke with **DelCo Water** about a water connection for the Club and received a packet that includes cost and easement proposals. \$5,410 for the tap and meter with a \$1,085 down payment. The rest of the cost would be paid in \$100 installments added to the monthly bill. Dave also met with Worley Supply (Plumbing Contractor that Delaware County works with) to get a complete list of materials and a quote for install the water line. \$3,042.02 for materials. \$8,542 total cost, but only need to pay \$4,127 up front – the rest paid in \$100 monthly payment with the water bill. Dave is trying to set up a Delco to address questions we have concerning the necessary easement(s).
10. **Range Safety Orientation.** The next one will be October 3rd starting at 6:30 before the Monthly Membership Meeting.

11. Griffin Sheppard received enough donations for his **Eagle Scout Project** which consists of providing benches on the Sporting Clays course. He should receive the BSA approval soon and start work this month.
