the hunting season as lot of members will be hunting. Bring any food to share if you want to and mingle with members.

11. **John Kemerer has volunteered to be the Chair of the new Membership Committee.** The committee also picked up other members at the meeting. David Diller and Dennis Strohmeyer. We had a meeting after the membership meeting. They have some great ideas. More to come on the development of that committee.!
12. **Youth Trap League have requested to add another evening of shooting** (besides Wednesdays) to accommodate some additional shooters. It was approved at the Trustee Meeting and will most likely be Mondays or Tuesdays at 5:30p for 7 weeks in the spring, and 5 to 7 weeks in the fall starting 2025.

It started on September 21st at 5:00 and will be held every other Saturday evening. Come out and check it out. The Trap shoots will include Red Bird, 10 Birds, Practice, 5 from the back fence, and Annie Oakley. Please let Tater know if you are available to help.
14. Tater mentioned that he **has not been catching any bass lately in the Club Pond.** The Pond Committee may want to check if the fish are surviving or being taken from the pond.
15. **New lighting has been installed** at the end of the Clubhouse as part of the building facia replace project. Hopefully this will eliminate the concern about lighting in this area of the property.
16. We can use **help restocking the refrigerator** with soft drinks, water and snacks. If you're in the Clubhouse, please check the frig and help us keep it stocked. If you see a deal on soft drinks and/or snacks, please pick them up and submit receipts to Rocky for reimbursement.
